SPECIAL PRESENTATION

Members of the Northern Shenandoah Valley Substance Abuse Coalition were on hand for our meeting to receive a **\$91,000** Local Grant from Rotary International. This is the first time a club in Virginia has received funding from this program and only the second time a club in our district has succeeded in receiving funding. Support came from not only Rotary International and local clubs (through our 2018 Kaleidoscope project), but also from districts in India and Taiwan with whom we are connected through GSE. Lauren Cummings of the NSVSAC thanked Don Butler, Scott Arthur, Past-President Julia, and all of the club members who worked so hard to raise the funds. The funding will be used to sponsor the "Give Me A Reason" campaign, which will provide parents with drug testing equipment and intervention resources for the youth of our area.



OUR LAST PROGRAM

Bret Hrbek, a member of the Rotary Club of Front Royal, spoke about his trip to India last year to help with **Polio Plus inoculations**. Like most Rotarians, he supported Polio Plus in small ways for the past 15 years, but it was his visit to India to personally administer vaccinations that turned him into a true believer.



Polio Plus was officially started in 1985 with a goal of raising \$125M to eradicate polio in the world. More than 30 years later, over \$1.7 billion has been raised to eradicate the disease in 99% of the world...2.5 billion children. Only 3 countries still have documented cases of "wild polio": Pakistan, Afghanistan, & Nigeria.

One of the greatest barriers to reaching the last one percent of the world is the fear and control exercised by the remaining countries. Part of Brett's challenge was to convince locals that the drugs were beneficial and not an attempt to sterilize their women and children.

During his visit, Bret and his group administered 42,000 doses of the vaccination and converted 763 parents from "no's" to "yes's" in terms of inoculating their children. Now that his trip is over, Bret and his team are dedicated to being ambassadors for Polio Plus throughout the district and throughout the world.
