Our Last Program - Oct 31

Our last program was presented by Clara Vassallo, who is a Rotary Exchange Student from Palermo, Sicily. Clara is currently spending the year attending school and living in Front Royal. She gave a charming talk about her native country and her experiences to date as an Exchange Student. Clara came to this country with concerns about her ability to speak English, which she had studied 9 years prior to this year, but she feels more confident each time she meets a new group. She thanked Rotary for the opportunity to expand her own horizons while teaching others about a homeland she loves. She described Sicily as a wonderful kaleidoscope of color, smells and history.

Clara's presentation highlighted some of Sicily's most famous places, including the Teatro Massimo Opera House, known for its perfect acoustics, the Greek Theatre of Syracuse, and The Valley of the Temples, where remains of seven temples dating to the second century BC can be seen. Her presentation also included beautiful photos from both the inside and outside of the Palermo Cathedral. When asked surprised her most about America, Clara responded with little delay that people in this country "burp a lot."
