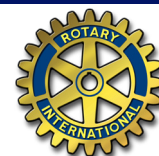

Our Beneficiary

The Shenandoah Valley Discovery Museum was founded in 1996 as an independent nonprofit educational museum providing opportunities for children and visitors of all ages to learn through imaginative play, simulation, experimentation, and exploration. What began as a traveling van providing engaging science-based education to children, quickly grew to a bricks and mortar location on Winchester's Old Town walking mall, and in May 2014, moved to a 19,000 square foot building on the end of the Old Town Mall.

During the 27 years since we opened, we have welcomed over 800,000 visitors! In 2022, we welcomed 50,173 visitors and with field trips, Summer Camps, and Educational Outreach, our total impact was 68,811.

One strategic goal of the Shenandoah Valley Discovery Museum is to have 75% of our exhibits to have iterative changes and/or add-on enhancements. The current water shed on our second floor is a favorite spot for our youngest visitors because it provides the opportunity to play in the water with fountains, small water toys and working in a lake "habitat". The proceeds from this tournament will help to completely upgrade our water shed area to better reflect water in the Shenandoah Valley and surrounding region. The educational component will share how very important water is and will always be to humans and our environment. Winchester Rotary's commitment to this project will echo the importance of water itself, water conservation and sustainability.
